# HORSE SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

**Entry Fees:** (Unless otherwise specified) Regular classes - \$20.00; Championship - \$25.00; Dressage - \$25.00; NHH&TA Fee - \$3.00 per horse. Entries close July 24, 2009. Post entries will be accepted but there will be a Post Entry Penalty of \$20.00 per horse for the first class entered; regular fees thereafter.

**Entry and Stall Fees Must Accompany Entry Blanks.** PERMANENT STABLING IS AVAILABLE. Stall fees are \$80 for the duration of the show. Stalls will be allocated on a first come, first served basis upon receipt of entry forms and check. Original bedding will not be furnished. Stalls will be available on Aug. 5 and must be vacated by noon on Sunday, Aug. 9th. For arrivals earlier than Aug. 5, 2009, YOU MUST CONTACT RON BOUCHER AT 603-463-7924. A \$16.00 per day fee will be charged for early arrivals.

**Camper Hook-ups with water and electricity** will be available at a charge of \$80 for the weekend. For arrivals earlier than Aug. 5th, YOU MUST CONTACT RON BOUCHER AT (603) 463-7924. A \$15.00 per day fee will be charged for early arrivals.

No persons will be allowed in the ring except the required individuals.

**Refunds:** Stall fees are not refundable unless they can be resold. There will be no refund of entry fees on classes, which are held unless due to bona fide injury of horse (with veterinary's certification required) or rider in equitation classes (doctor's certificate required).

**No person shall approach a judge** unless they first obtain permission from the **Show Steward**. The Steward will not permit any exhibitor or person to speak with the Judge until the horse and/or rider in question has completed its last class of the show. Any exhibitor disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.

In all classes open to registered animals only, the proper registered name and number must be listed on the entry blank, and owners must be prepared to produce registration papers.

In classes in which horses compete collectively, the in-gate will be closed 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

The management reserves the right of declining any entry and to return any entry fee before the opening of the Show without being liable for compensation.

**NHH&TA will support the USEF and NEHC and/or any affiliated state organization in any disciplinary action against exhibitors, which involve sportsmanship or the good conduct of shows or indebtedness and will extend these actions to all NHH&TA affiliated shows.**

The management reserves the right to vary or change officials or judges, to cancel, combines or divides any classes as entries warrant.

Only out-of-state horses will be required to present current Coggins Test Numbers. Proof of rabies vaccination for all animals must be available upon request.

Prize money vouchers will be awarded in the ring. These vouchers may be turned in at the office. There is a 60-day deadline from Aug. 8, 2009, to submit vouchers for payment after that, all vouchers are void. Management is not responsible for vouchers turned in after the deadline.

Management is not responsible for errors or omissions on the published class list. The NHAHA Summer Jubilee Horse Show will be conducted under the current rules of NEHC and NHH&TA.

The Deerfield Fair Association, Deerfield Fairgrounds, New Hampshire Arabian Horse Association Summer Jubilee Horse Show, The Horse Show Committee and all horse show officials or committee members will be responsible for any accident that may occur to any animal, person or property, and each exhibitor shall hold them harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings or liabilities from any such accident or loss of property caused to or by the property or employees of such exhibitor.

### **ENGLISH SHOW HACK DIVISION Non pointed**

1. Competitors enter the ring in a counterclockwise direction at the normal walk or normal trot.
2. Light contact must be maintained with all reins at all gaits. A judge may not request that gaits be performed only on snaffle or curb.
3. Judges are required to consider the performance at each gait equally in adjudicating this class.
4. Horses may show with a braided mane and tail. Braids may be secured with tape, yarn or rubber bands. Decorations are prohibited.
5. Entries will be eliminated by any fall of horse or rider during the class.

### **Appointments.**

1. Bridle shall be light, show type; either single snaffle, double (full) or Pelham. Kimberwicke bit is permitted. Browbands and cavessons other than hunter or dressage types are prohibited. Unconventional tack such as figure eight, drop, or flash nosebands are not permitted.
2. English saddle of any type is required. Girths of either leather, white web, nylon string or suitable material.
3. Martingales, breastplates not allowed.
4. Acceptable Hack attire is required. It consists of conservatively colored coat, breeches and boots. A conservatively colored hunting cap, derby or protective headgear is mandatory. Protective headgear may be worn without penalty. Formal attire consisting of white breeches, top hat and tails may be worn. It is usual to wear such attire after 6:00 p.m., or in Championship classes.
5. Spurs, whip or crop optional at the exhibitor's discretion.

## ENGLISH SHOW HACK DIVISION (continued)

### Non pointed

#### Qualifying Gaits.

A Show Hack horse is not necessarily a Dressage horse, nor an English Pleasure horse. Elevation and high knee action are not to be emphasized. The Show Hack is a suitable section for the well-trained animal. Show Hacks must be balanced and show vitality, animation, presence, clean fine limbs and supreme quality. Soundness is required. The collected and extended gaits must be called for; i.e., collected walk, extended walk, normal walk; collected trot, extended trot, normal trot; collected canter, extended canter, normal canter and hand gallop. At the discretion of the judge, horses while on the rail may be asked to halt and rein-back. A Show Hack shall be able to perform all of these gaits with a noticeable transition between the normal, collected, and extended gaits. The horse must be under complete control and easily ridden. Obedience to the rider is of prime importance. If the horse exhibits clear transitions in a balanced and level manner, appearing to be giving a comfortable and pleasurable ride, he is performing correctly for this class.

1. Walk, a four-beat gait: Straight, true and flat-footed.
  - a. Normal Walk: Regular and unconstrained, moving energetically and calmly forward.
  - b. Collected Walk: Strides are shorter and higher than at the normal walk. The head approaches the vertical, but should never move behind it. Pacing is a serious fault.
  - c. Extended Walk: The horse is allowed to lengthen frame and stride while rider maintains light rein contact. The horse should cover as much ground as possible without rushing.
2. Trot, a two-beat gait: Free-moving, straight, rider maintaining light contact with horse's mouth at all times.
  - a. Normal Trot: Light, crisp, balanced and cadenced, with rider posting.
  - b. Collected Trot: The horse's stride is shorter and lighter, maintaining balance and impulsion. The neck is more raised and arched than at the normal trot as head approaches the vertical line, never moving behind it. Rider is sitting.
  - c. Extended Trot: Maintaining the same cadence and performing at medium speed, the horse lengthens its stride as a result of greater impulsion from the hindquarters. Horse should remain light in rider's hand as it lengthens its frame. Rider is posting.

**ENGLISH SHOW HACK DIVISION (continued)**  
**Non pointed**

3. Canter, a three-beat gait: Straight on both leads, smooth.
  - a. Normal Canter: Light even strides, should be moved into without hesitation.
  - b. Collected Canter: Marked by the lightness of the forehand and the engagement of the hindquarters, the collected canter is characterized by supple, free shoulders. Neck is more raised and arched than in normal canter as the head approaches the vertical line, never moving behind it.
  - c. Extended Canter: Maintaining the same cadence, the horse lengthens its stride as a result of greater impulsion from the hindquarters. Horse should remain light in rider's hand as it lengthens its frame.
4. Hand Gallop: The hand gallop is performed with a long, free, ground covering stride. The amount of ground covered may vary between horses due to difference in natural length of stride. The distinction between hand gallop and extended canter is, the latter being the ultimate linear extension of stride within the hand of the rider; the hand gallop being a looser, more free elongation of stride and frame of the horse. A decided lengthening of stride should be shown while the horse remains controlled, mannerly, correct and straight on both leads. Extreme speed to be penalized.

## ACADEMY DIVISION\*\*

**Saddle Seat Attire:** Kentucky jods, boots, shirt and tie. Vest, helmet and gloves are optional. Helmets are mandatory for all riders under the age of 12. Sweater, sweatshirts and turtlenecks that do not carry a farm name or log are permissible in cold weather. NO riding coats or derbies.

**Hunt Seat Attire:** Breeches, boots and helmet, shirt & tie. NO riding coats. Sweater, sweatshirts and turtlenecks that do not carry a farm name or logo are permissible in cold weather.

**Mount:** Must be a horse that is REGULARLY used in a lesson program. Braiding is optional. There are no shoeing restrictions. Protective boots are permissible. Horses may cross-enter from the regular horse show to Academy Classes PROVIDED these horses are SCHOOL\*\* horses. Snaffle bridles or full bridles may be used. No neckties on horses.

Riders may not cross-enter between divisions (for example: a rider may show in EITHER Walk/Trot or Walk/Trot/Canter, BUT not both.) A leadline rider may not show off the leadline at the same show.

Headers for leadline riders MUST be at least 18 years of age.

Once a rider has shown off the lead, he/she may not return to the Leadline classes.

Once a rider has shown at the canter, he/she may not return to Walk/Trot classes.

In classes that require a posting trot, riders 6 and under shall not be judged on diagonals.

Helmets must be approved for horseback riding. NO bike helmets.

Once a rider has competed on ANY level wearing a full suit, they are ineligible to compete in academy classes for that season.

**\*\*Definition of a school horse:** A horse who is used to each a number of different riders in any given week, and whose temperament and manners are suitable for a novice rider. The quality of the animal has no bearing on his eligibility.
